



AFP-Greater Atlanta Chapter National Philanthropy Day Awards Program

Guidelines for Submitting Nominations

1. Nominations for any award may be submitted by an individual AFP member, an AFP organization or non-member individual or organization.
2. The deadline for nominations for AFP – Greater Atlanta Chapter’s Awards for National Philanthropy Day is Friday, March 9, 2018 at 11:59 p.m. EST. Late entries will not be accepted.
3. All nominations MUST be submitted using the forms available on the AFP- Greater Atlanta Chapter website and sent via email. Nominators should use the corresponding form for each award category and follow the instructions listed on the form. When the form is complete, please attach your document to an email and send it to jjones@asginfo.net.
4. All nominations MUST address all of the criteria set out for each award. Narratives should contain complete, clear and concise answers to the criteria. Answers to each question are limited to one page (font must be at least 11 point and may not be less than single line spacing).
5. Nominations will be judged on the responses to the criteria. Supporting letters are allowed.
6. Incomplete nominations, or nominations that do not address all of the criteria, will not be considered.
7. Residency in the Greater Atlanta area is required.
8. Individuals must have been alive on March 9, 2018 to be eligible for nomination for the 2018 awards.
9. Award winners are not eligible to be re-nominated for the same award previously won.
10. Nominations from previous years must be re-submitted to be considered.



AFP-Greater Atlanta Chapter 2018 Volunteer Fundraiser of the Year

This award honors an individual or family who demonstrates outstanding skills in coordinating and motivating groups of donors and volunteers for fundraising projects for the benefit of charitable institutions. The recipient must have demonstrated exceptional leadership skills in coordinating groups of donors and volunteers for major fundraising projects for more than one nonprofit organization.

To complete the nomination, please submit a brief explanation of nomination (include relationship to nominating organization) and describe how your nominee qualifies for the award, no longer than 100 words.

4. Please answer the following questions and note the weight of scoring for each section. Answers should not exceed a total of (1) page per question.

- a. For EACH organization/cause for which the nominee has helped raise funds, provide description of (1) ability to organize and manage campaigns and groups, (2) funds raised, (3) time, effort and personal financial commitment and (4) IMPACT the nominee and his/her work had on the organization's ability to provide programs and services.
(0-65 points)
- b. Description of both the nominee's ability to lead, motivate, manage and inspire others, as well as the ability to work within a team.
(0-20 points)
- c. Description of the nominee's support of other nonprofits where he or she may not have led fundraising efforts, but was active on boards and committees and gave and volunteered to the organizations.
(0-15 points)
